Thanks so much for your willingness to contribute an essay. This is just a short reply.

It would be wonderful if you can write about how the zoning and regulations shape buildings in different cities. For example, as far as I know, there is no prescribed FAR (FSI), BCR (GSI) and building height rule for each zoning area in London, whereas in Korea each zoning area has specific FAR and BCR rules. Thus, in the extremely dense Korean cities, the FAR Game is played using a triad of variables – 1) small but expensive plot; 2) FAR, BCR, and other rules; and 3) urban architecture.

If you touch upon why and how our theme is relevant to the discourse of architecture and urbanism today, it would be a great help. Please find attached my paper. In addition, I will send you the images, diagrams, locations of 36 selected buildings for the exhibition next week. They will help you to understand the background of our theme and exhibits. I am reading some chapters of your book now.
