-1 to 2 Storey Single-Family Detached House

-3 to 4 Storey Multi-Family House (under 660m<sup>2</sup> and 19 units)

-3 to 4 Storey Mixed-use Building (Retail Spaces on the Ground Floor)

-3 to 4 Storey Row House (above 660m<sup>2</sup>) or 3 to 4 Storey Tenement House

-High-rise Apartment Building (above 15 Storey)

Note that the title (under 7 stories) does not include the large apartment building. Is that not a problem?

The above is good, save the one correction. Note that **in the document** there are many cases where 'Storey' is spelled 'story'. I assume you know that and will be changing it to the above.

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
